

ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE STUDENT GUIDELINES FOR ETHICAL USE

Respect for Privacy

- Use care when sharing personal information with Al systems.
- Understand how your data is collected, stored, and used.

Academic Integrity

- Use AI tools to enhance learning and understanding of content, while ensuring work remains your own.
- The use of Al tools to generate or modify academic content in a way that violates academic integrity principles, such as plagiarism or cheating, may result in disciplinary action.
- Credit sources appropriately, whether human or Al-generated, to uphold academic honesty and integrity.

Responsible Use

- The School District of the Menomonie Area Student Acceptable Use Policy (362) should be followed for the use of all technology, including Al tools.
- Students should not use Al tools, or any technology, that bullies others or disrupts the learning process or educational environment.

Critical Thinking With AI Tools

 Students should approach Al-generated content critically and evaluate its validity, relevance, and potential biases by cross-referencing with trusted sources.

Sharing Concerns

 Students should report items of concern related to issues with district supported Al Tools and/or its inappropriate or unethical use to teachers and/or school administrators.
