

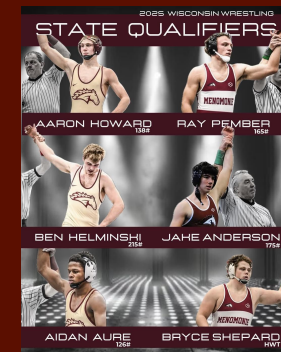

- High School band, orchestra and Choir perform for MMS students and staff.



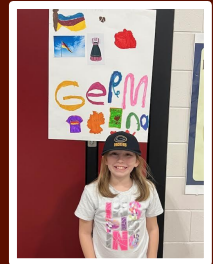
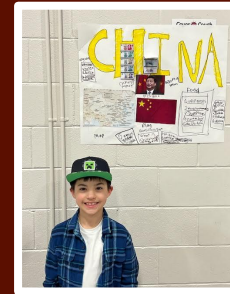
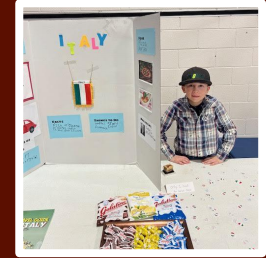
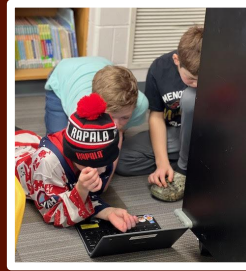
Downsville Elementary School
