
















Projected Share of Total Population: Age Group 0-19






Workforce Pipeline






Projected Share of Total Population: Age Group 20-69






Projected Share of Total Population: Age Group 70 and Older










Fertility Rates






WI Labor Force Participation Rate by Age


Labor Force Participation Rate by Age






Labor Force Participation Rate

Labor Force Participation Rate (%)












Labor Quantity Challenge

Retired to Employed Ratio






<u>Labor Supply Projections for</u> Wisconsin



Job Supply Scenarios






