



Menomonee High School Relationship Mapping Data 2022-2023

In October of 2022 the MHS staff conducted the relationship mapping exercise with results indicating that the staff had supportive relationships with almost all students in grades 10-12. In 9th grade, staff reported not having a supportive relationship yet with a higher percentage of students. Staff was encouraged to continue to develop and/or maintain strong relationships with all students. In January of 2023 students were asked if they had a supportive relationship with at least one staff member. About 85% of students who responded indicated they did have a supportive staff relationship. MHS staff was encouraged to reach out to students who indicated not having a supportive relationship in hopes of developing that connection.

Initial Survey Results

MHS staff and students completed the survey for a second time during May and early June of 2023. The teacher reported data indicated a higher percentage of supportive relationships in the 9th, 10th, and 11th grade levels while maintaining the same level in 12th grade. Despite multiple attempts to have all MHS students complete the survey the second time, we did not reach the same level of participation as we had in January. MHS had about an 82% participation rate in January but in May this dropped to about 46%. This could be due to busy student schedules and responsibilities or potentially reduced interest in taking the survey a second time. Because of this drop in participation, it is more difficult to compare the data. It is encouraging that less students indicated that they don't have a supportive relationship when given the opportunity to do so.
