

# After School Academic Support Proposal

In alignment with the SDMA mission and strategic plan, an Afterschool Academic Support Program is being proposed to be held at the Middle School. This program will provide support primarily for Math and ELA content areas. Additional support of other content areas will be provided once Math and ELA work has been completed. The vision for this program is to increase student achievement and competency in Math, ELA, as well as increasing student confidence as learners.

## Program Outline

- Program would operate from 3:15-4:45 in the MMS Library
- o 4 SDMA staff, 3 hours per week
- Goal is to have 45 students consistently attend (potential grow as need grows)
- o Program would be scheduled quarterly following the Middle School athletics calendar
  - Ex. Session 1 Nov. 30th- Jan. 14th, Session 2 Jan. 18- March 10
- o Planning to offer support in-person and online via Google Meet
- Attendance will be taken at each session along with students indicating the content area in which they are needing help
- O Data will be kept (i.e. attendance, grades, missing assignments...)
- o Budgeted Cost for Pilot Program: \$9,000 \$25hr for Teachers

#### • Joining the program

- o Parents will sign students up and based on teacher referral/suggestion
- o Family would need to provide transportation for student at pick up

#### • Student Requirements

- Students in the program would be required to attend regularly
- Students must come prepared with assignments/missing work

### • Staff Requirements

- Teachers will provide a positive, productive, safe learning environment
- Teachers will meet individually and in small group with students
- Teachers will reteach/remediate Math and ELA content, and offer general education support

#### Growth Potential and Partnerships

- Potentially increase at the Middle School based on need during Spring Semester
- o Potential continuation into 2022-2023 school year
- Potential partnership with Boys & Girls Club (they are currently working on funding for a pilot club at MMS)
- o Potential tutoring partnership with UW-Stout
